PAPIO-MISSOURI RIVER NRD  
TAX LEVY

Shall the Papio-Missouri River NRD, upon approval by a 2/3 vote of its Board of Directors as provided by law, be authorized to issue Flood Protection and Water Quality Enhancement Bonds for the purpose of paying costs of design, right of way acquisition and construction of multipurpose projects and practices for storm water management, including flood control and water quality, such bonds to be issued and sold in one or more series from time to time, to bear interest at such rate or rates, and to become due at such time or times as may be determined by the Board of Directors; and

Shall the Papio-Missouri River NRD cause to be levied and collected annually a special levy of taxes against all the taxable property in the District for the purposes of paying principal and interest on such bonds, which tax levy may exceed the statutory bond levy limit of one cent on each one hundred dollars of taxable valuation within the District by an amount up to an additional one cent, but which shall be included within the overall statutory tax levy limit for the District?

CITY OF OAKLAND  
MODIFY SALES & USE TAX
